

In the Name of God Amen: the 10<sup>th</sup> Day of February in the year of o<sup>r</sup>  
 our god and King our King the hundred eighty and six, Elizabeth the fourth of  
 your parish in the county of York being weak in body, full of years and  
 of full memory, thank to Almighty God, falling to Remembrance the  
 uncertain estate of this transitory life, and that all flesh must yield  
 unto Death, when it shall please God to call, I do make, constitute, ordaine  
 and devise this my last will and Testament, In manner and forme follow-  
 ing, Revoking and annulling by these presents, all and every Testament and  
 Testaments, still and still, here tofore made by me and forlorned, either  
 by word or writing, and that to be taken for my last will and Testament  
 and none other, and first being penitent and sorry from the bottom of  
 my heart, for my sinne past, most humbly desiring for my goodnesse-  
 forth the same, I give and commit my soule unto Almighty God my  
 Father and Redeemer in whom I live by the merit of Iesus Christ, I  
 trust and believe assuredly, to be saved, and that my soule with my body  
 all the honorall Day of Resurrection shall rise againe with joye, and  
 through the merit of Christe shall have possession, and dwell in the Kingdom  
 of heaven prepared for his Elect, according to be decently buried  
 in such and in such place as my Son Robert Head shall see meet, and  
 for the following my Temporall Estate, I give, sell, give, sell, give, sell  
 as it shall please God I give and devise my debts to be paid upon me, I give  
 order give and dispose of in manner and forme following, that is to say,  
 that all my Debts and dues, that I owe in right or Confiance to any man  
 or person or persons whatsoever, be truly paid in convenient time after my  
 decease, by my Executor hereafter named -- I give and devise  
 unto my said son Robert Head, one Negro man named Coler and Brigitt his  
 wife, and one Mallico boy named Harry, and Negro woman named Ann  
 Bolly with her Child, Mallico boy named Dick, and Negro man named  
 my one French boy named Nicholas Morroto, and one woman Toruan  
 named Mary Jones his wife, the said Negroes I give unto my said son Robert  
 with their servants -- I give I give and bequeath unto my son Francis  
 Head, one Negro man named Sandy, one Negro woman named  
 Negro boy named Coler, with their servants -- I give I give and bequeath  
 unto my son Benjamin Head and Negro man named Bill with  
 his wife with her servants, I give I give and bequeath unto me, one  
 Head and Negro man named Jeffery and Dimmo his wife, with her  
 boy named Tom, and one Negro boy named Bill, and one  
 named Jack my said son Thomas Head his wife and servants

Dutie as was paid me full sum of twenty five pounds sterl into  
 my Exchequer, for named, provided it be not paid before my  
 decease, the said Negroes I give unto my said Son Thomas with their  
 furniture, -- And I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth  
 Christian one Negro Woman named Kato, the said Negro Woman named  
 Begg with her Child a Mollatto Girl named Dina with their furniture. --  
 And I give and bequeath unto my Grandson Son Thomas Christian one  
 Negro Girl named Kato, with her furniture, -- And I give and bequeath  
 unto my <sup>Grand</sup> Daughter Elizabeth Christian one Negro Girl named Mubriak w:  
 her furniture. -- And I give and bequeath unto my Grand Daughter Elizabeth  
 Christian one Negro Girl named Stanak with her furniture. -- And I give  
 and bequeath unto my Son Benjamin the furniture that I lay on with  
 the furniture belonging to it three pairs of shoes, three silver spoons  
 three silver dishes and one iron pot. -- And I give and bequeath  
 unto my Son Thomas, one good silver bed and furniture, three pairs  
 of shoes, three silver spoons three powder dishes and one iron pot  
 And I give and bequeath unto my Daughters Elizabeth Christian and Mary  
 each all my wardrobe apparell to be equally divided between them  
 And I give and bequeath unto my Son Benjamin one young mare of  
 three or four years old. -- And I give unto my Son Thomas one young  
 mare of three or four years old. -- And I give unto my Son Benjamin  
 two pounds of powder, and one hooper with his proportion of the  
 sort of salt which belonged unto his Brother George Dead Lord  
 according to his Division and order made. -- And I give unto my Son Thomas  
 two young ewes, and one hooper, with his proportion of the stock of salt  
 which belonged unto his Brother George Dead Lord according to the Division  
 aforesaid made. -- And I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Anne  
 Warner her mourning ring usually used. -- And my will and desire is  
 that all such servants, free, and other movables, as shall belong unto my  
 two Sons Benjamin and Thomas Dead as before mentioned, remain and be  
 in the care and custody of my Son Robert Dead, until my said two Sons  
 Benjamin and Thomas have attained the age of one and twenty years, allowing  
 unto my said two Sons such necessary Apparell as they shall have  
 occasion for during their Monage, to be allowed out of the profits of their  
 here mentioned servant Labors, as by my will and desire that my Son  
 Robert Dead when my two Sons Benjamin and Thomas do come to age  
 are required their Apparell, that then they have allowed to each of them  
 by my said Son Robert, be sufficient for one year of provision for them  
 and their servants, and will their servant sufficiently cloathed. --  
 And my

This my Will and desire is that if ill Shou'd please God to waite himselfe either  
 of my two yonger Sone Benjamin or Thomas before hee come to the full  
 Age of one and twenty yeares that then the said Thomas the younger and I  
 would soone as given and bequeathed to him that is Directed, but if he should  
 please God that both my said two yonger Sone should dye before they come  
 to the age as aforesaid that then my two Sone Robert and Thomas should God please  
 and enjoy what soever is given and bequeathed unto my two Sone Benjamin  
 and Thomas to be equally divided betwene them. And it is my will  
 Desire and I do hereby give and bequeath unto my Sone Robert the  
 all my Herke of Cattle, Sheepe, horses, hagg goods, Chattels, Debt due to me, and  
 accounts whatsoever it may be or shall be, or belong to me, with all already  
 bequeathed, to any person before expressed in this my last Will and Testament  
 Remainsing, Appointing and directing my well beloved Sone Robert to be  
 his sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament, - It is my Will and  
 Desire that my well beloved Sone Mr. Thomas (Purman, Mr. Edward Chappin  
 and Mr. Thomas Barber be our executors to see that this my last will and  
 Testament be carefully and truly performed.
